

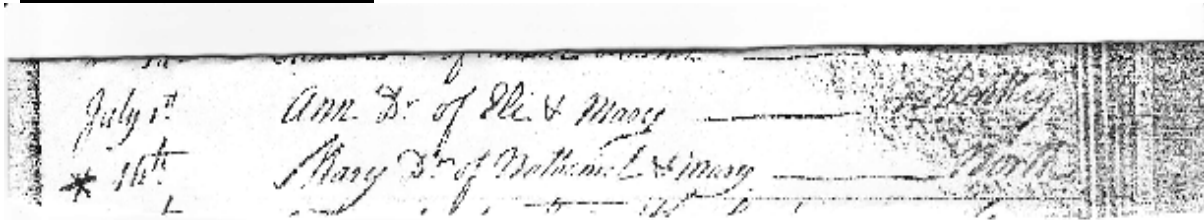
## THE PARENTS OF MARY NORTH (WIFE OF JOHN NORTH III)

The parents of Mary North, wife of John North III are Samuel North and Mary Haywood. Mary North was christened at Kegworth, Leicestershire 14 July 1790.

Samuel North and Mary Haywood are the parents of Mary North( 1790). I emphasize this statement because family tradition has indicated that Nathaniel North and Mary Haywood were the parents of Mary North. Samuel North and Mary Haywood were married at Lockington 5 April 1790 in Leicestershire and moved soon after to Kegworth where they raised their family. Examination of pedigree chart #1 shows the proper connection of the parents of John North III and Mary North his wife. Note in the pedigree, that both John North's and Mary North's mothers maiden names are Mary Haywood and that John North III's father is John North II and Mary North's Father is Samuel North.

Unfortunately, there are numerous errors and inconsistencies in the collected family genealogical records for Samuel North and Mary Haywood. These errors have grown out of the Kegworth parish record which incorrectly gave the name of Nathaniel North as the father of Mary North when she was christened at the Kegworth parish church 14 July 1790. The birth of Mary North according to the Kegworth parish record is as follows:

### Birth of Mary North 1790



*Mary Dr. of Nathaniel & Mary North baptized 14<sup>th</sup> July 1790 (F0952280).*

Since the above record clearly states that Mary North is the daughter of Nathaniel North, how do we prove that her father's name was actually Samuel. In the evidence that follows we will show the above record is in error.

### The primary evidence comes from Temple work done by her son William North.

The LDS baptismal, endowment and sealing records for Mary North's parents, (William's Grandparents) were performed in the St. George Temple by her son William North in 1874 and 1878. The baptism and endowment records are shown below:

The Heir in the above records, William North, born 3 April 1815, is the son of JohnIII and Mary North, who joined the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in England and emigrated to Fillmore in Utah. Anna Maria Jensen North is his wife. William North was born in Kegworth where his grandparents lived just before his parents moved to Loughborough. Undoubtedly he was well acquainted with his maternal grandparents and knew their names. Note that Samuel North, not Nathaniel North, and Mary Haywood were baptized and endowed by him and his wife, on the same day. (note: this distinguishes the records they did for John NorthII and Mary Haywood, his father's paternal line. See their file.) Note, again that Samuel is the name of Mary North's father on these index cards.

William North also performed the sealing of Samuel North and Mary Haywood, his maternal grandparents at St. George. (Unfortunately I could not get a photocopy of the sealing as this is not allowed but I was allowed to copy the information.) It is as follows:

In the case of the sealing, Mary Haywood is given her married name of Mary North whereas for the baptism and endowment the maiden name of Mary Haywood is used. It is obvious, however, that the sealing refers to Mary Haywood as she is being sealed to her husband who is Samuel North. The baptism and endowment give the same corroborative evidence and in this case the maiden name of Mary Haywood is used.

Although the above evidence should be sufficient to prove that the father of Mary North is Samuel North, not Nathaniel North, there is other circumstantial evidence which confirms that Samuel North and Mary Haywood are the parents of Mary North..

1. A marriage between Nathaniel North and Mary Haywood has never been found. Neither has a death of Nathaniel North been found at Kegworth or any nearby parish; whereas, a birth, marriage and a death for Samuel North is available. The birth of Samuel North and the marriage of Samuel North and Mary Haywood is recorded in the Lockington parish record. It would be extremely doubtful if both a Nathaniel and a Samuel North married a woman of the same name of Mary Haywood and then settled in Kegworth and each had children born there.
2. Lockington parish records:  
Kegworth and Lockington share a long border. Together they are less than four miles across. Each is about 4 miles in length. Samuel North was born at Lockington and Mary Haywood was born at Kegworth so from birth they would have lived within four miles of one another. The Lockington parish record, F819694, showing the birth of Samuel North is shown below (second last line):

Below is shown the marriage as well as the banns for marriage of Samuel North and Mary Haywood (spelled Hewood) at Lockington. Note that the marriage took place on the fifth of April 1790 and banns were published three Sundays in March. The record of banns states that both Samuel and Mary were from Lockington. The marriage itself states that Samuel is from Kegworth and Mary is from Lockington. In this case the places of residence are reversed. (For further proof of this, all nine of Samuel's brothers and sisters were born at Lockington. Not listed in this document.)

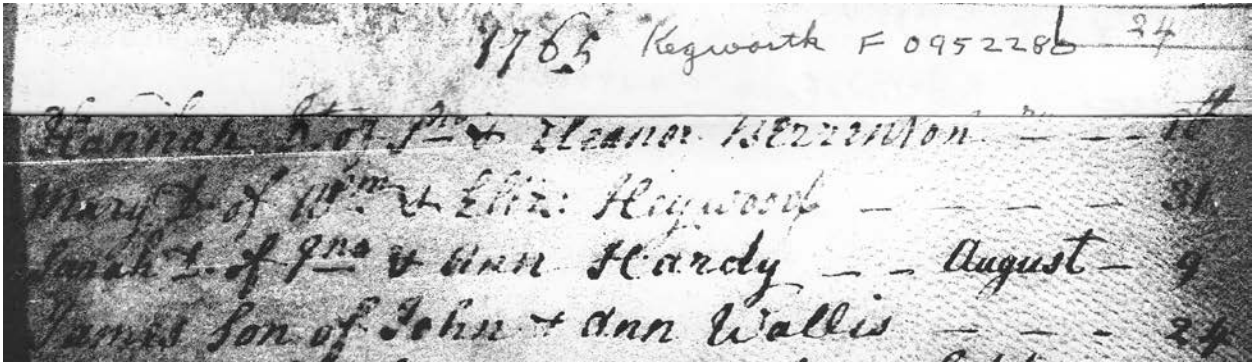

Note the witnesses in the marriage: Jane North is a sister to Samuel North and Thomas Halford is related by marriage to Samuel North. Note too that the surname in the above marriage of Mary is spelled Hewood not Haywood.

Banns: # 8 Samuel North and Mary Hewood both of Lockington were published 7, 14, 21 March 1790 (F819694)

Inasmuch as the Temple ordinance data shows that Samuel North and Mary Haywood are the maternal Grandparents of William North, and as William North is the son of John North III and Mary North we can reasonably eliminate Nathaniel North as the father of Mary North in favor of Samuel North. Furthermore we have adequate proof of birth and marriage records showing that Samuel North married Mary Haywood in the immediate vicinity of Kegworth (at the neighboring parish of Lockington.) It is also necessary to show that Mary Haywood who married Samuel North is actually the daughter of William Haywood and Elizabeth Wallis. In doing so we will also show that Mary North (1790) is the sister of Samuel North (1806) one of the seven children of Samuel North and Mary Haywood. The christening record of Mary Haywood in 1765 from the Kegworth parish record is as follows:

*Kegworth parish record F952280 2<sup>nd</sup> line: Mary Dr. of Wm & Eliz. Heywood christened 31 July 1765 (Note that the child on this record who is christened after Mary was christened in August.)*

**The North children belonging to Mary Haywood and to Samuel North or Nathaniel North**

- 1: Mary\* dr. of Nathaniel and Mary North chr. 16 July 1790 (the child Mary North is our direct ancestor.)
- 2: John son of Samuel and Mary North chr 9 Feb 1793; buried 26 September 1806 age 13
- 3: William son of Samuel and Mary North chr 18 Feb 1796
- 4; Catherine dr of Samuel and Mary North chr 27 Dec 1798
- 5: Elizabeth dr of Samuel and Mary North chr 7 Sep 1802; buried 18 October 1821
- 6: Samuel son of Samuel and Mary North chr. 10 May 1806 \*\*
- 7: Joseph son of Samuel and Mary North chr 5 Mar 1808; buried 21 May 1822.

\* Mary North 1790 fits neatly in this family and so she has six siblings one of whom is a younger brother named Samuel North (b1806.) We will use this information to provide further evidence to show that both Samuel North Jr. (1806) and Mary North 1790 are the children of the same Mary Haywood and grandchildren of William Haywood and Elizabeth Wallis.

**Samuel North(1806) the Younger Brother of Mary North(1790)**

1841 census Kegworth, Leicestershire

**Explanations:**

\* Mary North age 76 is clearly the mother of Samuel North Jr. age 35.

\*\*Mary age 41 is the wife of Samuel North Jr who is 35 and the children are their children.

The birth date of Mary North (1765) is calculated from her age on this census which matches exactly the christening date for Mary Haywood (shown above) who is the daughter of William Haywood and Elizabeth Wallis. This shows that Mary North (1765) above must be the wife of Samuel North Sr. (deceased 1838)

**In Summary**

Mary North (1790) is the sister of Samuel North Jr (1806). She is also the sister of the other children of Samuel North and Mary Haywood.

Mary North (1790) is the daughter of Mary Haywood (1765)

Samuel North Jr's mother, is the daughter of William Haywood and Elizabeth Wallis.

Therefore Mary Haywood, who married Samuel North, is the daughter of William Haywood and Elizabeth Wallis. This eliminates Nathaniel North. **Mary North (1790) is the daughter of Samuel North and Mary Haywood**
