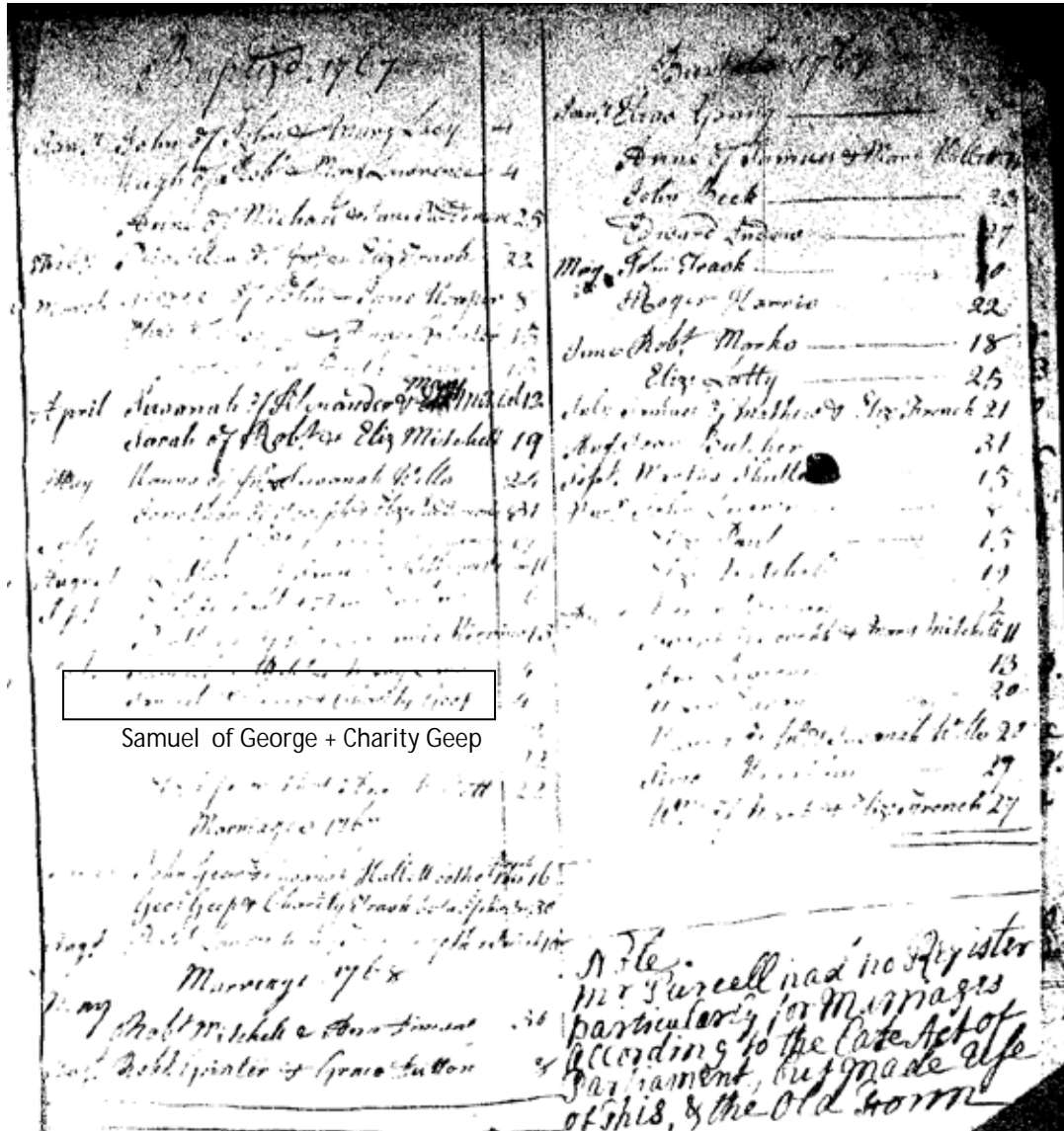


The story of Samuel Geep (1767) of Merriott and Mary England of Lopen as told in the parish record of England. Also included are other Geep relatives who lived in Merriott.

## Section 1: Birth of Samuel (1767) Geep

Samuel was baptized in the Parish of Merriott, Somerset, England FHL Film# 1526760 Entry clear and readable as written

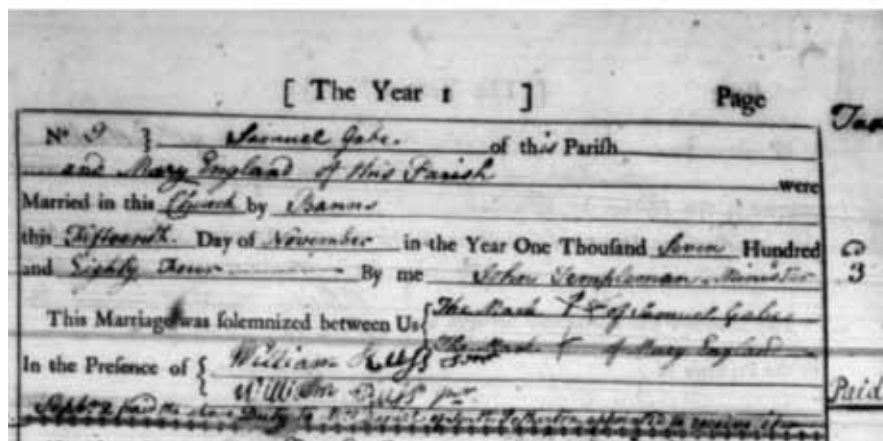

## Section 2: Marriage of Samuel (1767) Gabe and Mary England

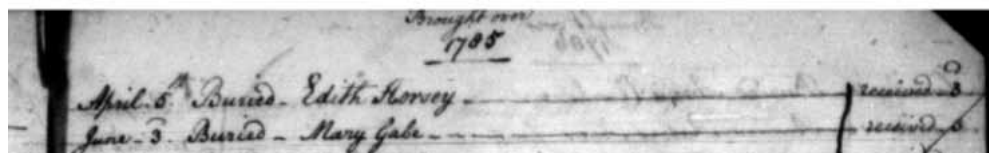
Their marriage was in the parish of Lopen.

### Section 3: Children of Samuel (1767) Geep and Mary England

This first record is of a possible child of Samuel and Mary. It is a burial record for a Mary Gabe in 1785, but no parents are listed. It is one of only 3 records using the surname Gabe. The other two are the marriage of Samuel (1764) Gabe to Ann Druce in 1786 and Samuel (1767) Gabe to Mary England in 1784. Mary is assumed to be the daughter of Samuel (1767) and Mary England, as Samuel (1764) and Ann has not yet been married. We also know that this isn't Samuel's (1767) wife as she bore other children after this date.



Samuel (1767) and Mary England next child is born in Merriott.

The next child that I assigned to this couple is a Samuel born about 1789. No baptism record was found for this Samuel (1789) in the Church of England in Merriott. A Samuel with this estimated birth year goes on to marry a woman named Elizabeth, and they christened a child named Harriett in 1814. No marriage for Samuel (1789) and Elizabeth has been found. In the analysis of the parish records and the families at this time, Samuel (1787) and Mary seemed to be the most logical parents.

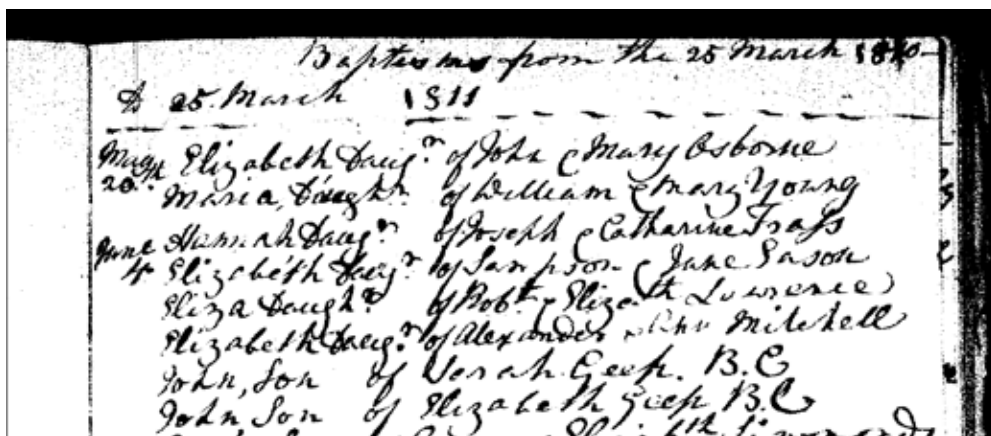

The next frame is of two sisters, Sarah and Elizabeth (daughters of Thomas Geep and Alice Lawrence) christening base born children with the same name of John. They are nieces of Samuel's. (1867)



This last frame is a child of a Samuel and Charity Geep's Chr. 9 May 1812. I do not know how this Samuel fit in to the Geep lines. I put him here just to alert you of him.
